Dear HFS IRIS Clients:

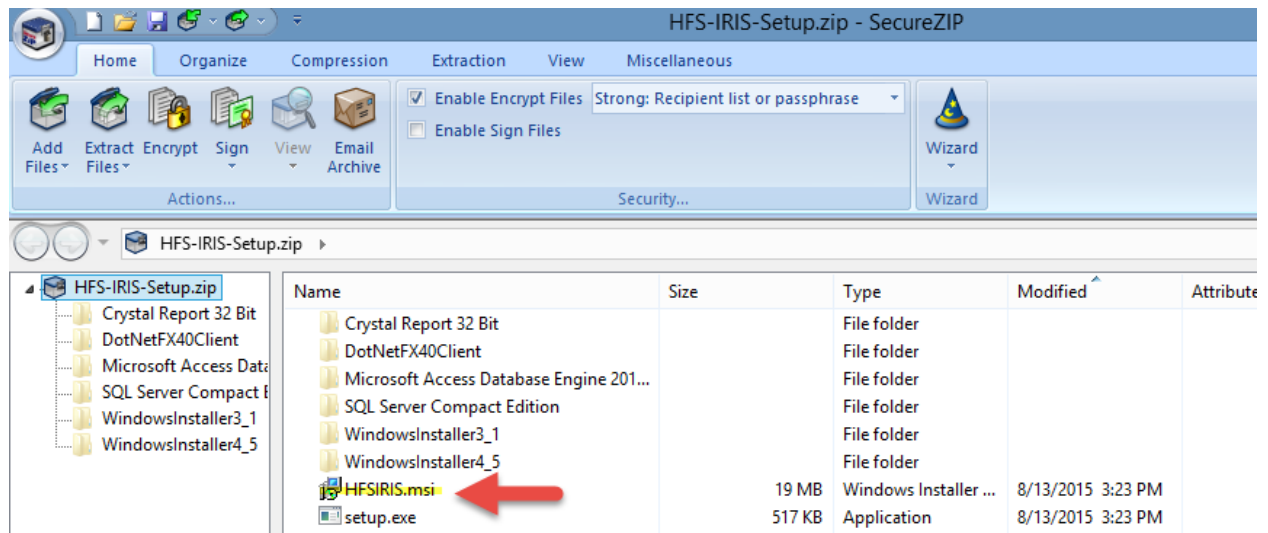
We recently posted a new update for the IRIS SQL system. The changes are summarized below.

IRIS, version 5.3.0.0:

- D12066 – IRIS - Corrected an issue when the user requested the Import Master Variance Report selecting the full database, the system errors out.
- D12067 – IRIS - Changed the naming convention of the M & A dbf files to Mxxxxxx_YYYYMMDD.dbf and Axxxxxx_YYYYMMDD.dbf which was relayed on the 2-3-16 CMS / Vendor call. This allows providers the ability to know the FY of the IRIS files and reduces the chances that the files would be over written on export.
- D12075 – IRIS - Revised the Residency Calendar start date so that any resident's with grad date or cert date from 7-1 to 9-15 will revert back to 7-1 otherwise will begin with the 7-1 that follows. This is solely used for our warning edit and not an error.
- D12076 – IRIS - Fixed an issue with the Audit Report ran with just edits, we were improperly identifying overlap FTE's when there was no overlap of the assignment.
- D12080 – IRIS - Fixed an issue with export where the date modified caused an error when importing, this was isolated on one file and not all exports.
- D12098 – IRIS - Corrected an issue with Batch Import when the M or A file had a bad record, it was stopping the process, now it will alert the user of the provider with the bad record and continue.
- D12125 – IRIS - Corrected an error when importing files as a replacement of existing data.

If you are currently on version 5.2.0.0 or 5.2.0.2, you can now retrieve the updates from the Home Page of the IRIS system with the Check For Updates box in the top right corner of the page, just select the Click Here button.

If you are on an earlier version, you will need to go to our website www.hfssoft.com and go to the download page. You may be asked to log in. You will want to select the IRIS link to download. If you have already installed the IRIS software, when you retrieve the download, you will see the following inside the zipped file (ignore the dates below); you will only need to run the HFSIRIS.msi. If you have not installed the system yet, then run the setup.exe.
